

SELAH PARADE DIVISIONS

VEHICLE DIVISIONS REQUIRE INSURANCE

FLOAT DIVISIONS - Any motorized vehicle, or trailer pulled by a motorized vehicle, that is designed, decorated or modified specifically to participate in parades or similar events.

CIVIC FLOAT - Any float sponsored by an organization to promote specific cities, regional areas or events. Examples might include those sponsored by a chamber of commerce or community festival organization.

YOUTH FLOAT - Any Float sponsored by a nonprofit organization whose programs and membership are limited to youth under the age of 18. Examples might include Boy/Girl Scouts, Campfire or church youth organizations.

ADULT FLOAT - Any float sponsored by a nonprofit organization whose programs and membership are not limited to youth under the age of 18. Examples might include RSVP, Kiwanis or churches.

COMMERCIAL FLOAT - Any float promoting any business, product or enterprise regardless of sponsorship. **This division requires a \$50.00 entry fee.**

COMMERCIAL FLEET VEHICLE - Any motorized vehicle that's used or designed for routine business purposes. The vehicle is designed and decorated to promote a business, product or enterprise. Any vehicle bearing a business name, logo, slogan, etc, is a commercial vehicle. **This division requires a \$50.00 entry fee.**

COMMERCIAL SPECIALTY VEHICLE - Any motorized vehicle designed, modified or reconditioned for parade and/or demonstration purposes. The decorated vehicle is entered to promote any business, product or enterprise. Any vehicle bearing a business name, logo, slogan, etc, is a commercial vehicle. **This division requires a \$50.00 entry fee.**

COMMERCIAL VEHICLE - Any vehicle promoting a business, product or enterprise that just has the name of the business on it, unless the vehicle can be judged in another division. **This division will not be judged, but requires a \$50.00 entry fee.**

ANTIQUE VEHICLE - Any individual motorized vehicle that was manufactured before 1940. It has been maintained or restored to its original design and condition. Original or similar replacement parts were used in its restoration.

CLASSIC VEHICLE - Any motorized vehicle manufactured after 1940. The vehicle has been maintained or restored to its original design and condition. Original or similar replacement parts have been used in its restoration.

CUSTOM VEHICLE - Any motor vehicle that has been modified in appearance, design or performance from its original production standards.

ROYALTY VEHICLE - Any motorized vehicle not qualifying as a float carrying royalty that is representing a community, organization or event. Examples might include Royalty from other community's, and Northwest America Pageant.

OTHER VEHICLE - Any motorized vehicle, which does not qualify for any other parade division or category.

GOVERNMENT VEHICLE - Any motorized vehicle sponsored by, and representing any federal, state, or municipal jurisdiction agency, department or district. Examples include police, fire and military vehicles.

COMMERCIAL - Any entry promoting a business, product or enterprise, which does not qualify in the float or vehicle division. Examples might include a company mascot or an equestrian unit entered to promote a business, product or enterprise. **This division requires a \$50.00 entry fee.**

NEW BAND INFORMATION

SCHOOL BAND - Any group of students who play musical instruments, and are sponsored or recognized by a public or private school. Divisions include High School AAA, AA, A/B, Middle School and Jr. Hi Schools. The bands should be in the staging area no later than 9:00. **Judges are on the announcer trailer in front of Wells Fargo Bank right before the second turn. The Bands need to be playing as they go by them. We are going back to the old way of doing the staging. Which is check in at the table at Save On Food parking lot then we tell where to go un the staging area.**

SCHOOL DRILL TEAM - Any group of students who perform any marching and/or dance maneuvers along the parade route and who are sponsored by a public or private school. Divisions include High School AAA, AA, A/B, Middle School and Junior High schools.

YOUTH MARCHING - Any group of two or more youth who's membership and programs are limited to youth under the age of 18 who march the parade route in formation.

ADULT MARCHING - Any group of two or more individuals whose membership and programs are not limited to youth under the age of 18 who march the parade route in formation.

YOUTH & ADULT WALKING - **This division will not be judged.** Any group or individual that walks the parade route and are not in formation.

NOVELTY - Any entry that does not qualify in any of the divisions. However, it has crowd appeal. Examples might be Clowns, Jugglers, Motorized Drill Team or Band and Drill Teams that are not sponsored by schools.

EQUESTRIAN AND ANIMAL DIVISIONS REQUIRE INSURANCE & THEIR OWN CLEAN UP CREWS.

EQUESTRIAN ROYALTY - Any royalty, either individual or court, representing a community, regional area or event that ride horses.

INDIVIDUAL EQUESTRIAN - Any individual that is riding, or otherwise accompanying any horse, pony or mule.

GROUP EQUESTRIAN - Any group of two or more individuals that are riding, or otherwise accompanying horses, ponies and mules.

BUGGY/WAGON TEAM - Any vehicle propelled by one or more horse, pony, mule or other animal.

ANIMAL - Any entry, which contains one or more live animals that does not qualify in any of the equestrian divisions. Examples might include Dog Gone K-9s or a llama farm.
